Today, more than 380 persons are members of the network and exchange virtually or during face to face meetings about their experience, challenges, successes and lessons-learned. This exchange is key to improve the daily work of SDC staff and implementers working in the water sector.

Location: The internship will be based in St-Gallen.

Duration: The working time is preferably 60% for 10 months with a start planned on 16th of September 2019. Both working time and duration period are subject to discussion with the candidate.

This Internship is an excellent opportunity to gain insights in Swiss development cooperation and acquire experience in innovative approaches for water.

Tasks: The trainee will support the Réseau activities including but not limited to:

- Global face-to-face event in Switzerland, a two days event where members meet, exchange and learn from each other;
- Regional face-to-face meeting of the Middle East and North Africa Sub-Réseau;
- Specific learning exchange activities for the Sub-Réseau Africa;
- Webinars on water related topics;
- Activities related to the Trend Observatory in water, an initiative aiming at keeping the Réseau members informed about emerging trends and innovative approaches in the water and related sectors;
- Training offer for Réseau members;
- Documentation of best practices of SDCs and its partners;
- Innovative tools to stimulate the knowledge sharing, learning and encourage exchange among members.
