The assignment included the development of a realistic and appropriate Master Plan of the District Hospital Bumthang which could stand out as an example or a useful model for other Dzongkhag hospitals wherever appropriate. All existing and future service lines and facilities had to be appropriately outlaid on the site plan and awareness among officials and stakeholders in the Dzongkhag created.

Main tasks were:

- To provide technical inputs and suggest strategies to address the identified gaps and constraints
- To provide preliminary design options for a Mother& Child Clinic
